As a result of the workshop you will be better placed to offer mentoring support to volunteers, management committee members and tutors etc. who work in the ACE network.

Mentoring can help unleash the potential of everyone to enhance their skills and expand their horizons.

Who is eligible?

This opportunity is available to people who are involved in adult and community education. They could be tutors teaching classes at a community centre (voluntary or paid); voluntary one-to-one tutors; people involved in the organisation of ACE; administrators, committee members or managers.

Successful participants will:

- be currently involved in ACE provision;
- have strong links with and be able to identify other ACE providers in their community or regional area;
- be prepared to mentor other people involved in the ACE sector;
- be available to attend a one day workshop in Perth on Monday 26 October 2009;
- be able to present the results of their mentoring experience at next year's Link State conference 29 April – 1 May 2010.

The workshop
