The new online art history courses will transfer the best of the highly successful on-campus model to an online environment. From February 2010, enrolled students will be able to log on via the internet to watch the Gallery Director and Curators delivering lectures in the Gallery's collection and exhibition displays, and to view works from the collection in great detail.
