Across all industry sectors, large employers – particularly those with hundreds of employees – are more likely to have a high level of engagement with the vocational education and training (VET) sector and to use e-learning to deliver structured in-house training. The above information comes from the recently released **2009 E-Learning Benchmarking Survey**. It also highlights the latest e-learning trends and attitudes in VET and allowed participants to benchmark their e-learning activities nationally. The survey also looks at the use of e-learning in smaller businesses across Australia.
