### Step 1:

Use your Username and Password to log in to the LearningTimes Australia (Ita) site. If you are not yet a member of LearningTimes, select the 'Join' button to create your Username and Password.

### Step 2:

In the 'Highlights' section at the top of the homepage, select 'Registration' to fill in a brief form. Click on 'Sign Me Up!' once you have completed the form.

You will receive an automated email confirmation of your registration with important information about how to participate in the event.

Importantly, this email will give you instructions on how to 'Edit your profile' and change your time zones so that all of the event's sessions correspond to your local time. The email will also explain how you can indicate your interest in live sessions by using the 'Set Reminder' function.
